



Summer Camp Tips and Information

Before Camp

- Complete forms and return in person, by mail or e-mail to summercamp@exploration.org.

Check-In and Check-Out

- Campers must be checked in and out each day by an adult or sibling of at least 18 years of age. This adult needs to be listed on paperwork and have photo ID available to check out a camper.
- Look for signs directing you to camp check-in.
- Full Day Camps: Check-In is between 8:45-9:00 a.m. Check-Out is between 4:00-4:15 pm.
- Half Day Camps: Check-In is between 8:45-9:00 a.m. or 12:45-1:00 p.m. Check-Out is between 12:00-12:15 or 4:00-4:15 p.m.
- Pre-K Check-In is between 9:15-9:30 a.m. Check- Out is between 11:30-11:45 a.m.
- Before and After Care is available for all camps except Pre-K. Ask for details.

What to Wear and Bring

- Closed-toe shoes
- Clothes that can get messy
- Lunch and afternoon snack
- Water bottle
- All items labeled with camper's name

Please Be Aware

- Refrigerators, microwaves, and eating utensils are not available.
- Staff cannot administer medication.
- Camps are open to students of all abilities.
- Every effort will be made to avoid allergens; however Exploration Place is a public facility.
- Dependent upon camp theme, campers may or may not spend time exploring the museum or viewing a dome show.
- Cell phones, electronics, and toys are not permitted at camp.
- Exploration Place is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Behavior Expectations

- Campers will:
 - Participate in all camp activities
 - Use appropriate language and conversation
 - Respect for the museum, staff, and other campers
- Bullying and violence will not be tolerated.
- Camper behavior will be discussed with parents. If troubled behavior does not improve, campers may be dismissed from camp.
